



1. INTRODUCTION

Every governor has a copy of the plan. The plan runs for a calendar year. We believe this enables the school to respond quickly and effectively to the issues which are highlighted in Raise on Line, Fisher Family Trust Data, SATS data in general and in house testing data. The Autumn Term is therefore a review, evaluation and planning term. This cycle also enables the school to 'catch up' over the summer if any particular schedule has lagged behind. The Head Teacher reports on progress every term to governors. Staff are regularly engaged in the review of progress through all the plans.
